## MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE JERSEY VILLAGE BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT

October 18, 2013 – 12:00 p.m.

The Board of Adjustment of the City of Jersey Village, Texas, convened on October 18, 2013, at 12:00 p.m. in the Civic Center Meeting Room, 16327 Lakeview, Jersey Village, Texas.

# A. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Henry Hermis at 12:00 p.m. and the roll of appointed officers was taken. Board Members present were:

### B. Designate Alternate Members to serve in place of any absent Board Member.

Chairman Hermis appointed Alternate Member No. 2, Ken Nguyen, as a voting member in the absence of Board Members Gerald Laws and Robert Cunningham.

### C. Nomination and Election of Chair and Vice Chair for one year term.

Chairman Hermis opened nominations for the office of Chairman for a one year term beginning October 1, 2013 and ending September 30, 2014. Board Member Simchak nominated Board Member Henry Hermis. Board Member Sappington seconded the nomination. With no other nominations being made, the vote follows:

## D. Consider approval of the minutes for the meeting held on September 13, 2013.

E. Conduct a public hearing on J. Curtis Haverty's application for variance to the Jersey Village Code of Ordinances, Chapter 14, Section 14-225(h)(1), permitting applicant to maintain the existing slab elevation, which is less than 18 inches above the 100-year base flood elevation, for two proposed additions (108 sq. ft. closet extension and a 6 sq. ft. bay window) which will directly communicate with the single family home located at 15405 Ashburton, Jersey Village, Texas 77040.

Chairman Hermis called item E and opened the public hearing at 12:02 p.m. on the request of J. Curtis Haverty's application for variance to the Jersey Village Code of Ordinances, Chapter 14, Section 14-225(h)(1), permitting applicant to maintain the existing slab elevation, which is less than 18 inches above the 100-year base flood elevation, for two proposed additions (108 sq. ft. closet extension and a 6 sq. ft. bay window) which will directly communicate with the single family home located at 15405 Ashburton, Jersey Village, Texas 77040.

Board Secretary Courtney Rutherford stated for the record that all notification requirements for both the City and the applicant had been met.

Mr. Haverty was in attendance for the public hearing. The Building Official Christian Somers gave background information on the request for variance. He explained that Mr. Haverty would like to construct a minor addition of 108 square feet to his home. The addition is a closet for the master bedroom and a bay-window in the master bathroom. Mr. Somers explained that since this is new construction it is considered a substantial improvement under the City Code.

Discussion was had between the Board, Staff, and Mr. Haverty regarding the request. The Board reviewed Section 14-225 and determined that this addition would not increase the risk of flooding.

With no other party or individual signing up or requesting to speak at this public hearing, Chairman Hermis closed the public hearing 12:33 p.m.

F. Discussion with possible action on J. Curtis Haverty's application for variance to the Jersey Village Code of Ordinances, Chapter 14, Section 14-225(h)(1), permitting applicant to maintain the existing slab elevation, which is less than 18 inches above the 100-year base flood elevation, for two proposed additions (108 sq. ft. closet extension

Board Member Sappington seconded the motion. The vote follows:
