



## **DISASTER RECOVERY – UPDATE #6, May 12, 2016**

### **★ DEBRIS REMOVAL**

-On May 9, 2016, two additional claw trucks were sent to Jersey Village to assist with debris removal. The crews will be working continuously Monday through Friday from 7-5, and on Saturdays from 7-4. The streets cleared as of 5-12-16 are: Elwood, Sue, Ginger, Lakeview, Philippine, Equador, Hamilton Circle, Colwyn, Zilonis Court, and Leeds.

-A second round of debris removal is expected to start on May 23, 2016. This is the absolute last date to have storm damaged materials pulled from your home and placed in the right-of-way for collection.

-Electronics and appliances are being picked up separately.

### **★ DEBRIS PLACEMENT**

-Please ensure that all storm debris is placed in the right-of-way and off of your private property for collection by the contractor's claw truck. Per the City's contract with Ashbritt, only debris placed in the right-of-way will be collected.

### **★ MOBILE DISASTER RECOVERY CENTER (MDRC)**

-As a reminder, FEMA opened a MDRC, located at Foundry United Methodist Church, 8350 Jones Road. Hours of operation are from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday, and from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. on Saturdays.
